# 1. ADMINISTRATION

The Committee approved the current Agenda and the minutes of the November 6, 2013, MIC meeting. Ms. Laura Walter, PJM, reviewed the MIC process of approving problem statements and issue charges. The committee reviewed the MIC work plan and stakeholders requested that changes from month to month be highlighted. The Committee was informed that the Markets and Reliability Committee assigned the Energy Reserve problem statement and issue charge to the MIC.

### 2. <u>FINANCIAL AND NODE LIMITATION ON UP-TO CONGESTION TRANSACTIONS PROBLEM</u> <u>STATEMENT</u>

Ms. Noha Sidhom, Inertia Power LP, presented a problem statement regarding limitations on up-to congestion transactions. A stakeholder proposed a friendly amendment to have any group working on this review Dr. William W. Hogan's study and perhaps invite Dr. Hogan to the meeting to get his thoughts. The friendly amendment was considered, but it was determined that the amendment applies to the issue charge that will be up for endorsement at the January MIC meeting. The Committee endorsed the problem statement with <u>124 in favor</u>, <u>31 opposed and</u> <u>34 abstentions</u>. The Committee will be asked to endorse the issue charge at the January MIC meeting.

# 3. FINANCIAL TRANSMISSION RIGHTS TASK FORCE SUNSET

Mr. Tim Horger, PJM, discussed sunsetting the Financial Transmission Rights Task Force (FTRTF). The Committee endorsed sunsetting the group by acclamation with <u>0</u> objections and <u>13</u> abstentions.

### 4. MANUAL 28

Ms. Suzanne Coyne, PJM, gave an informational update on changes to Manual 28: Operating Agreement Accounting. The committee endorsed these conforming changes by acclamation with <u>0</u> objections and <u>1</u> abstention.

### 5. <u>EMERGENCY ANNUAL DEMAND RESPONSE MAINTENANCE OUTAGE REPORTING PROCESS</u> <u>PROBLEM STATEMENT</u>

Mr. Pete Langbein, PJM, requested approval for Demand Response Subcommittee to clarify business rules that will implement a process for Curtailment Service Providers to report Annual Demand Response Maintenance outages.



The committee endorsed the problem statement by acclamation with <u>0</u> objections and <u>0</u> abstentions. The committee will be asked to endorse the issue charge at the January MIC meeting.

### 6. PROPOSED DEMAND RESPONSE PRODUCT SUBSTITUTION CLARIFICATION

Mr. Pete Langbein, PJM, presented proposed manual language changes that clarify tariff provisions that allow demand response capacity product substitution during a product specific emergency demand response dispatch. The committee will be asked to endorse the manual language at the next meeting.

Mr. Hal Loomis, PJM, presented an informational update on the export credit requirements.
