- ICSA Superseding Language
 - Revise PJM Tariff, Attachment P, section 1 to account for circumstances when an ICSA supersedes an already-effective ICSA
 - Mirroring language in PJM Tariff, Attachment O, section 1
- ICSA Automatic Termination Provision
 - Revise PJM Tariff, Attachment P, Appendix 2, section 14.1.1 to make termination contingent upon: (1) PJM receiving notice of the occurrence of the four conditions; and, for ICSAs on file with the Commission, (2) PJM cancelling such ICSAs in accordance with Commission rules and regulations
