

Migration to Account Manager - Timeline

eDART user account management has been migrated to Account Manager

- Migration to Account Manager

Communication will be sent out for each milestone.



Formal User Migration period ended on 12/13/2023.

- Ongoing outreach to companies that still have eDART legacy users
 - potential compliance concern
 - updated revocation deadline
- Active accounts remaining in eDART Legacy not revoked at this time:
 - Companies working with vendors to transition to SSO
 - CDW agreements still in progress for CDW Agents
- Bulk update option no longer available



Key Messages

- If you haven't already, please initiate the eDART migration to Account Manager as soon as possible
- All account requests for eDART accounts must be addressed in <u>Account</u> <u>Manager</u>.
- CAMs can leverage the eDART User Access Revoke Request Form to identify user accounts that *will not* be migrating to Account Manager.
- The Migration to Account Manager <u>Guide</u> offers guidance and assistance for completing migration



Migrated users...

- Can only log into eDART via PJM Tools
 - Train: https://edartssotrain.pjm.com
 - Prod: https://edartsso.pjm.com
- Can use Single Sign On to log into eDART
- Will require PKI certificate for browserless interaction with eDART (if the user/system account does not already have one)
- Should contact their company CAMs for password resets and unlocking accounts

Deliverables:


- Functionality to submit and view ratings lookup tables
- Functionality to manage AAR exceptions and TO Methodology
- AAR Seasonal rating functionality
- Ability to pull ratings for the Operations Time Horizon for all eDART users
- Enhancements available in Train only
 - CLI to support current and new functionality
 - UI updated to reflect new functionality
