- Emergency Procedures and All Calls systems tested
 - DR Hub is not used in the drills as there is no way to distinguish between Drill and Real LM Events

Simulated implementation of all Emergency Procedures



- Great CSP All Call acknowledgement rate
 - All CSPs with LM registrations acknowledged LM calls
 - Most of them on the first call attempt
 - This is important as acknowledgment on first call attempt avoids redials, minimizing the time to get the message out

Some old entries on the All Call list need to be removed



- DR Hub electronic (web service) notification is PJM's <u>primary</u> means to deliver dispatch instructions for Load Management DR
 - CSPs should always follow instructions received from DR Hub

 Emergency Procedures website and All Call are <u>secondary</u> means of communication
