Operating Committee (OC) for fuel assurance requirement, testing requirements, transition process; Markets Implementation Committee (MIC) for compensation issues.

Key Work Activities

1. Review education on the fuel assurance status of existing PJM black start resources.
2. Review existing black start RFP proposal evaluation criteria relevant to fuel assurance.
3. Develop fuel assurance requirement for all new and existing black start resources.
4. Develop testing / verification requirements for demonstration of fuel assurance requirement.
5. Develop transition plan for new and existing black start resources to meet fuel assurance requirements.
6. Discuss compensation issues related to new and existing black start resources meeting fuel assurance requirements.
7. Discuss associated changes to PJM Governing Documents and Manuals.
8. Discuss alignment of fuel assurance for restoration alignment with PJM Fuel Security Study.

Expected Deliverables

1. If needed and as appropriate, revisions to PJM Governing Documents and Manuals

Decision-Making Method

Tier 1, consensus on a single proposal

The stakeholder effort should take 6 months. The start date should be August 2018. Priority level is High, Timing is Near Term, and Meeting Frequency is Monthly.
