

TRANSMISSION FACILITY CUT-IN PROCESS UPDATE

Issue Source

PJM must have all proper parameters in place prior to energization of a 'cut-in' ticket in order to monitor the system accurately and maintain reliability in accordance with NERC Standards FAC-008 and FAC-011.

Issue Content

PJM has identified the need to update manual language specific to the cut-in process to indicate that the end time of an outage marked 'cut-in' will be extended by one business day if new data has not been submitted or existing parameters have not been verified by 11:00 the day before scheduled energization.

Key Work Activities and Scope

1. Review PJM Manual 03 and add language detailing the addition of the ticket end time extension
