- According to Manual 34, detailed voting reports are only permitted to be shared at the Members Committee and all other stakeholder committees share voting results in aggregate form.
  - Specific voting details, including who voted and how are considered to be confidential and sensitive information.
- Standards will provide consistency across stakeholder committees and groups and protect data integrity.



## Polling & Voting Result Standardization

- There is no change to the manner in which voting results are shared today.
- This standardization seeks to align polling results with the same consistent approach utilized for voting.
- With the exception of the MC, results will be shared in aggregate detail only.
  - Total # of responses, Total values in each response grouping, and Percentage
  - We will refrain from showing details in specific break-down such as number of affiliates or unique responders.

### Polling Exceptions:

- Need to solicit input or feedback that requires qualitative responses and attribution.
  - Advanced stakeholder notice required.
- Specific to polling, if the volume of non-member participants is significantly high and is found to affect the polling results, non-member participation can be specifically designated when reporting results to stakeholders and the Parent Committee.
