## LM Testing DY 2023/2024 Review/Discussion What went well

- CSP event notifications via web service polling, web postings and email notices performed as expected
- Testing completed without needing to cancel/reschedule any test
- No reported issues with energy settlements
- LM compliance records created without problems
- Retest scheduling CSP/PJM worked as expected
- Retest selection process in progress, no issues to date

## LM Testing DY 2023/2024 Review/Discussion Some issues

- A few CSPs reported having issues getting data from certain EDCs. This was primarily during the early months of the DY.
- Received a request to add test <u>times</u> (in addition to the already posted test <u>dates</u>) to Demand Response Test Schedule notification webpage after the completion of an event
