- Monica Burkett, PJM, welcomed the group and reminded RSCS attendees that Manual 3A, which was reviewed at the July RSCS, will be going for final endorsement and manual change at the MRC meeting on August 25.
 - A. Ashwini Bhat and Monica Burkett reviewed Antitrust Guidelines, Code of Conduct, Public Meetings/Media Participation, and Webex Participant Identification Requirements.
 - B. They also indicated that a Webex report will be used to capture meeting attendance
 - C. Ashwini Bhat reviewed the agenda for the meeting. The agenda was approved with no objections and no abstentions.
