 - a. Phase 1 of eDART Browserless Refresh has been completed in eDART Training and Production
 - b. Phase 2 of eDART Browserless Refresh was completed on July 1 in the eDART Training environment and is expected to be implemented July 14 for the eDART Production environment
 - The filetransfer.jar legacy URLs will be retired in December 2021
 - d. Dynamic Line Ratings were discussed during 3/30/2021 OC Special Session. The associated eDART enhancements were implemented on May 27
 - e. External eDART files, .txt or .csv, will be converted to zip files in July 2021
