Definition of MSOC

- MSOC is the marginal cost of capacity
- MSOC is the competitive offer for a capacity resource
- MSOC is net going forward costs
- Retirement/mothball distinction is not meaningful for defining going forward costs
- Careful review of going forward costs
- CPQR is part of going forward costs
 - See IMM presentation on CPQR dated 03.24.2022
- Net CONE * B is not the marginal cost of capacity and should not be the MSOC.

MSOC

- Going forward costs do not include fixed costs
 - Tariff provides exception for APIR
- Going forward costs do not include short run marginal costs
 - Going forward costs do include maintenance costs
 - But if tariff permits maintenance costs in energy offers, maintenance costs are not includable in going forward costs for any generator
 - Need the same rules for all to prevent gaming
- Going forward costs do not include asserted opportunity costs to be a capacity resource
