PJM Member Requirements

- To apply for full PJM membership, an entity must qualify as
 - A Transmission Owner within the PJM RTO
 - A Generation Owner
 - An Other Supplier
 - An Electric Distributor (EDC)
 - An End Use Customer

Types of PJM Members

- **Full Members** – participants in the competitive wholesale electricity market that may be eligible to vote in the Members Committee (MC)
- **Ex Officio Regulatory Members** – federal and state agencies with regulatory authority over a PJM member (no voting rights in the MC)
- **Ex Officio State Office of Consumer Advocate Representatives** – eligible to vote in the MC
- **Emergency Customer Load Reduction Program Special Members** – special membership status for purposes of participating in the Emergency Customer Load Reduction Program (no voting rights in the MC)
- **Associate Members** – special membership status. Do not participate in PJM's markets. No voting rights in any stakeholder activities, working groups, or committees

Requirements for Application

- Must execute the operating agreement

- Different sections apply to different types of business

Requirements for Application

- Enclose a cover letter and executed agreements and send directly to the President of PJM Interconnection, LLC
- Select a primary Members Committee member and up to three alternates
- Meet the standards for interconnection to the PJM RTO (Control Center Requirements Manual

- Provide system data as appropriate
- Meet Creditworthiness Standards
- Receive the approval of the President of PJM

Credit Requirements

- Credit application/agreement must be submitted

Market Sellers (including but not limited to Generator Owners)	Not required	Required
Special Members Emergency Energy Only	Not required	Not required
Special Members Real Time Energy Only	Not required	\$500.00 plus 10% of each payment owed by PJM for a Load Reduction Event is withheld - not to exceed \$5,000.00 in a calendar year
Transmission Customers Only (not a member)	Not required	Not required
